

#### CAMPERS:

Children **currently** in Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Children who will be 5 years old by Sept. 2, 2014 (attending kindergarten in the fall) are also eligible.

#### CIT's:

(Counselors in training) volunteer positions for students currently in  $7^{th}$  and  $8^{th}$  grade.

#### COUNSELORS:

Paid positions for students who are currently in high school or college.

bring your completed application with you.

Everyone will be informed of their status, hired or not, by April 1, 2014. **PLEASE do not call or email prior to April 1 regarding your status.**

You must notify us in writing, or via e-mail (cmt@gracepa.org), at least 14 days before the session begins in order to receive a refund. There is a *\$50 per child* processing fee for ALL cancellations. Cancellations received less than 14 days before the session begins will not be eligible for a refund.
